At times of high rainfall, water flows past the drain and continues along the valley. Property is still vulnerable. A slight alteration in the camber of the road or a small ramp to guide the water into the drain would stop this.	
		Mr Paul Allen, Highways advised they need photographic evidence of the scale of the problem. It may be simply that the existing drains require cleaning to improve their ability to drain the water off the highway.
