	a. Highway Walkabout – representatives from the PC met with Mr Paul Allen and County Cllr. Hannaford on 13 th March to look at a number of issues:	Information
	 i. <u>Uneven Road</u> – by the Garden House, St Saviour's Hill and Top of Trethake. The road at Battery Lane was being undermined by roots from the large fir tree. Mr Allen thought they may just overlay with tarmac to level out. 	

	ii. <u>Blocked Drains</u> – drains at Mixtow, Butts Park, Top of Trethake and Tredudwell. Although the cyclical gang had dug out quite a few gullies some had not been done. The drain at Essa seemed blocked so water was bubbling up in the drain from the other side of the road and running over the top of the drain down into the field rather than under. It is hoped the gullies at Butts Park will be cleared of silt as a stop gap until the farmer landowner can be asked to allow a longer soak away in the field.	
	iii. Pont Bottom – the leat wall has broken through and the water is leaking out into the road. There were a few potholes on this section as well but filled with water.	
	iv. <u>Residents' Parking Signs, Bodinnick</u> – Cllr. Hannaford will request replacements as the green wall signs are not that visible.	
	v. <u>Chapel Flats</u> – the bottom one had been gutted and they said the top flat is a lot further along.	
	vi. <u>Road Signs at Butts park</u> – were very battered and rusted through. Mr Allen will order replacements.
