		 Footpath from Les Pieds dans l'Eau to Penmarlam – Ms Katie Jose, Countryside Officer advised she believes this enquiry may relate to path 24. CAT have this on our list of paths to inspect post COVID. Once the path has been inspected, she will able to update Members.
