



103/2020	<p><b>Information Only / Items for Future Agendas –</b></p> <p>a. <i>Anti-Social Behaviour</i> – Cllr. Adams reported there had been a recent incident of threatening behaviour when a child was abused whilst waiting for the public bus to their Secondary School. The parent of the child was unwilling to report the incident to the Police. Cllr. Adams had been met by concerned residents who had witnessed the incident and had explained to them that such matters should be reported immediately to the Police and, where appropriate, Cornwall Housing. A similar incident that happened on Polruan Quay had been reported to the Police</p> <p>Members had been told by the other agencies that they are unable to discuss such matters with the Parish Council, and we have no powers to act in situations like this. It was essential that anyone who witnesses incidents of ASB should report it to the Police. The more people who witness and report anti-social behaviour the more likely it is that something will be done about it. The Clerk to place a notice on the PC's website, emphasising this advice.</p> <p>The Clerk to bring these matters to the attention of County Cllr. Libby said there was some confusion about how and where to obtain a flu jab. Cllr. Adams had spoken to the Fowey River Practise and been told those who are fit to travel should register to receive a flu jab at Bodelva car park. Those who are infirm and physically incapable of getting to Bodelva will be offered a flu jab in Polruan. (The logistics as to how this will work are not yet known.) The Lostwithiel Medical Practise had set up a temporary clinic in the Scout Hut, Lostwithiel to provide a “walk through” flu jab service. The Clerk to write to Dr Waldon and ask for a similar service to be introduced for Polruan.</p> <p>d. <i>Blue Cottage, Bodinnick</i> – a builders’ van had been parked on the highway for a number of days whilst a delivery of builders materials was awaited.
