	Present – Cllr. Pat Moore OBE (Chair); County Cllr. Edwina Hannaford, Ms Emma-Jane Stubbins, SW Water; Ms Val Goulding, CC and Mrs Thompson (Clerk).	
1/2020	Apologies – Cllr. Adams (Vice Chair) and Mr Paul Allen, Highways. Mr Dave Owens was not present.	
2/2020	<p>Polruan Drains –</p> <p>a. Cllr. Moore spoke to the background. She said the issues with the drains at Fore Street had been recently addressed, but there are still problems with surface water in West Street.</p> <p>b. Mr Allen had reported via email that: “As far as I am aware the main surface water systems in Fore Street are the responsibility of SW Water with CC responsible for the gullies only and the short connections to the SWW systems.”</p> <p>“In West Street there is only one CC gully (near No.50) and connection into the SWW line that goes down the side of No.56 to the sea. To help the situation outside No.50 we would need to place another gully, with SWW permission, on top of the line outside No 56.” It was AGREED by SWW that this would be desirable.</p> <p>c. Ms Goulding was unfamiliar with the issues in West Street. She did not have a problem with Mr Allen’s suggestion.</p> <p>d. Ms Stubbins referred to the work already undertaken in Fore Street. There are two systems and it appears that the water system is underused and could take more water. Further investigation to be carried out with a view to addressing flooding issues further down the hill. Too much water is bypassing the gullies and it may be necessary to reposition some of them, by disconnecting from existing drain and bypass to underused drain.</p> <p>Ms Goulding said it had been found that there are some inaccuracies in their inventory which needs investigation. At present the gullies are cleared on demand and this is a basic service. Further up Fore Street it may be necessary to alter or lower the profile of some of the gullies.</p> <p>Joint investigations will be undertaken by Highways and SWW.</p> <p>Cllr. Moore said the drains need more regular maintenance, especially those involving St Saviour’s Hill. Ms Goulding said Maintenance on West Street is in accordance with protocol and it is walked every four months, is not a resilient network. Whatever happens is reactive.</p> <p>It is vital for proper maintenance that faults are reported preferably through the on-line reporting system. This will help with maintenance decisions. They could look beyond the maintenance schedule but to do this will need evidence, images or even better, video footage of incidents and water flows. Vigilant residents and their evidence would be welcomed. Reactive flood spots will be maintained but they need to know.</p> <p>Ms Goulding has asked for these to be checked and will discuss with Paul Allen whether there is any scope to have take-off points</p>	<p>Highways / SW Water</p> <p>Highways / SWW</p>

	<p>altered. She wants to look where the flows are when it is actually raining. There can be subtle level changes which alter flow. It may mean altering the surface profile. It is seeing where the water is going and then get it into the right place.</p> <p>e. Cllr. Hannaford urged everyone to report issues online. Ms Goulding said that if this identifies additional problems then this would inform extra maintenance visits.</p> <p>f. Ms Stubbins was asked for a copy of the CCTV Survey. She explained the drain was not in the best of condition and will need to be brought up to a good condition, but currently the drain is underused anyway.</p> <p>g. There is some investigative work to be done and it was AGREED to have another meeting in the New Year to receive a progress report.</p> <p>We asked to receive a copy of the CCTV footage but there is reluctance to part with this.</p> <p>h. Altogether a productive meeting with proposals from both parties of how we can move forward.</p>	Clerk
